### ARMS

A silver shield with three gold 8-pointed mullets on a red bend between two black cinquefoils.,

### CREST

Not available

### MOTTO

Nec opprimere nec opprimi (Neither to oppress nor to be oppressed).

**D**RENNAN, DRINNAN, DRYNAN. These surnames recorded in Galloway and also in the parish of Ballantrae, Ayrshire, are from Irish *O'Draghruiin*, from *draighneán*, 'blackthorn.' There were many individuals named Drynan and Drynen in the parish of Inch, Wigtownshire, in 1684. Some have changed their name to Drummond.
