DRENNAN, DRINNAN, DRYNAN. These surnames recorded in Galloway and also in the parish of Ballantrae, Ayrshire, are from Irish *O'Draghruiin*, from *draighneán*, 'blackthorn.' There were many individuals named Drynan and Drynan in the parish of Inch, Wigtownshire, in 1684. Some have changed their name to Drummond.
