ARMS	A blue shield with a silver bend cotised, on which there are three black billets.
CREST	Not available
MOTTO	None

HACKSTON. A curtailment of HALKERSTON, q.v. David Hackston of Rathillet, Covenanted leader, was executed 1680. An old account of the murder of Archbishop Sharpe calls him Haxton. David Hagstoun in Kippen, 1602 (*Dunblane*), and William Haikston, tailor in Edinburgh, 1685.
