HENRY, HENDRIE, HENDRY. These names are common in the districts of Ayr and Fife. The *d* is intrusive after *n*. Henricus, dapifer, was a witness c. 1183-88, and Henricus (Chen) was bishop of Aberdeen. 1282-1328. William Henry was witness in Perth, 1551, Allan Henry, burgess of Irvine, 1552 (*Protocols*, I), Hendyre Hendry, burgess of Stirling, 1562, John Hendrie was tenant of the marquis of Huntly, 1600, and William Henrie was member of Huntly Volunteers, 1798. As forename: Hendrie Ralstoun (1519) and Hendrie Dwn (1527).
