three silver boars' heads couped.

Hughson, 'son of Hugh,' q.v. John filius Hugonis, burgess of Aberdeen, 1317, Johannes filius Hugonis, dean of Christianity in Elgin, 1375, and Colynus filius Hugonis, tenant in ville of Butyll, 1376. Thomas Hugonis was a forestaller in Aberdeen in 1402, William Hugosoun, Baillie of Glasgow in 1433, and Andrew Hughson, forester general of the lands of Camsy, 1471. Hughsone 1483.
