Of local origin from the district of Kyle in Ayrshire. Walter of Kyle had a safe conduct into England in 1424, Margaret Kile possessed a tenement in Glasgow in 1428, George Kyle appears as burgess of Edinburgh in 1538, and John Kile and Thomas Kile were burgesses of Irvine also in 1538. Robert Kyle who appears in record as Baillie of Irvine in 1572 and 1590 is probably the Robert Kyle, burgess of Irwene, who was retoured heir of Angres Kyle, resident in Glasgow, I 1606, James Kyll was a cooper in Edinbugh in 1662, and David Kyle, portioner of Lassudden, 1772. The Kyles of Laurel Hill, county Derry, are of Scottish descent, Kyile 1556.
