LEE, LEY. Local. The earlier references point to an English origin. Alan de Leia witnessed a charter by Eschina Luxor Walteri a. 1177, and a later Alan de Leya witnessed a charter by Alexander, son of Walter, senescallus, 1246. Phelippe de la Leye rendered homage, 1296. Robertus de Lee, 1436. John Lie in Snook-miln, 1718.
