MACCOARD, MACCORD, MACCOURT. Maccord is an old surname in the parish of Ballantrae. Woulfe says same as *MacCuarta, MacCuairt,* "not improbably a corruption of *MacMhuircheartaigh.*" Old French MACKUIDY. Nigel M'Corde resigned the lands of Skeich'in the sheriffdom of Wigtoune, 1471, and Gilbert Makcorde appears in Wigtownshire, 1473. John M'Cord and George M'Cord were occupiers of Nether Barnele in Carrick, 1544, and William M'Cord was admitted burgess of Glasgow, 1627.
