



## Clan MACCOARD

<b>ARMS</b>	A gold shield with a black stripe on which there are three gold arrowheads; above the stripe are two red hearts and below is a single red heart.
<b>CREST</b>	Not available
<b>MOTTO</b>	None

**M**ACCOARD, MACCORD, MACCOURT. Maccord is an old surname in the parish of Ballantrae. Woulfe says same as *MacCuarta*, *MacCuairt*, "not improbably a corruption of *MacMhuirheartaigh*. ' Old French MAC-KUIDY. Nigel M'Corde resigned the lands of Skeich'in the sherifffdom of Wigtoune, 1471, and Gilbert Makcorde appears in Wigtownshire, 1473. John M'Cord and George M'Cord were occupiers of Nether Barnele in Carrick, 1544, and William M'Cord was admitted burges of Glasgow, 1627.
