MACWHIRTER. A form of MACCHRUITER, q.v., current in Ayrshire, the original home of the name. Andrew M'Whirter in Kirkhobble in record in 1749 (*Wigtown*). Rev. Alexander McWhorter (1734-1807), of Scottish parentage, took an active part in the American Revolution and was a trustee of the College of New Jersey, now Princeton University. McWhorter Street in Newark, New Jersey, is named in his honor. The name has become Mewhirter in the North of Ireland. Macquarter 1684.
