PERRIE, PEBRY. Donald Pery was tenant of Uthircloy, Ardmanoch, in 1504, Robert Pery held part of Kethyk in 1457, and William Pery had a tack of the eighth part of Kethik, called the Cothill in 1555. Antonius Pery was Baillie of the abbot of Scone in 1544, Alexander Perrie was admitted burgess of Aberdeen in 1611, and John Pierie was skipper in Aberdeen in 1689. Cf. PIRIE.
